Temporary Import/Export Permit

Complete **SAPS 520** in black ink

Attach the following documents to your application:

- Two copies of identity documents
- Copy of your passport
- Copy of competency certificate
- Copy of training certificates; POSLEC, SASSETA, or PFTC Certificate of Results
- Proof of address (not older than 3 months)
- Copy of each firearm licence for which the applicant wants to apply
- Invitation letter from the farm where the applicant intends to hunt.

Very Important:

- Permits are approved and issued by the Central Firearm Register in Pretoria, not at the local police station. Apply for a permit at least 21 working days before the departure date.
- SA Hunters recommends that firearm owners apply for export/import permits in advance and not at the border.
- All international airports have border police on duty who can assist with the transportation of firearms on aeroplanes.
- Hunters travelling with firearms from Botswana to Namibia must also obtain a permit to take firearms through Botswana. Ramathlabama border post can be used.
- Handguns are not allowed under any circumstances in Botswana or Namibia.
- A separate form must be completed for each firearm.
- Permits for Botswana cost approximately R300 (depending on the exchange rate). These permits are valid for 30 days and cannot be extended.
