SA HUNTERS – SANSSU – SATRA FRIENDLY EXPLORATORY COMPETITION

1. Introduction

SA Hunters, SANSSU and SATRA are working together in presenting a friendly shooting competition to introduce shottists to other shooting organisations and associations. It is a bridging event to give shottists more exposure to the shooting sport and to encourage them to continue participating and enjoying the shooting sport once they have completed their school careers.

2. Rules of the competition

- 2.1 **Date:** 15 June 2024
- 2.2 **Venue:** Eeufees shooting range, Voortrekkerhoogte Pretoria
- 2.3 **Time:** 08:30 – Opening and rules
09:15 – First detail starts
- 2.4 **Type of competition (rimfire and PCP rifles)**
 - 2.4.1 22.5m three-position shoot
 - 2.4.2 3 x targets (10 diagrams per target)
 - 2.4.3 10 x scoring shots per position
 - 2.4.4 30 rounds of bullets for scoring shots and unlimited bullets for practice shots.
- 2.5 A tuck shop will be available to buy refreshments.

3. Entrance fee

- 3.1 Rimfire: R50 per shottists per detail. Ammunition will be provided for use on the range.
- 3.2 PCP: R30 per shottist per detail with own pellets. Pellets will be on sale during the event.

Bring the following items:

- Own rifle. A few rifles will be available to borrow.
- Own equipment, e.g., shooting mat, knee pad, shooting gloves, spotting scope, rifle stand
- Masking tape to secure targets
- Own compressed air cylinders to refill PCP

4. Age groups

- 4.1 The following age groups are available: under 9, under 13, under 16, under 18, under 25 and senior. To qualify for an age group, e.g., the under-18 group, the shottists must still be 18 years old on 31 December 2024.

4.2 Shottists must bring their IDs or birth certificates to confirm their ages.

5. **Rifles and calibres**

5.1 **PCP rifles**

5.1.1 PCP rifles of 4.5 to 5.56mm calibre are allowed.

5.1.2 Shottists must bring their compressed air cylinders that meet the safety requirements of their organisations.

5.2 **Rimfire rifle**

Any action type .22 LR calibre rimfire rifle is allowed.

5.3 **Rimfire ammunition**

Only .22 long or .22 short rimfire ammunition with a maximum of 1100 fps is allowed.

6. **Sights and scopes**

The following sights are allowed:

6.1 peep sight, open sight, and scope

6.2 laser sights that project a beam on the target, are not permissible

7. **Other equipment**

7.1 Shooting mat for prone or kneeling positions

7.2 Knee pad

7.3 Rifle slings and hand stop for prone and kneeling positions

7.4 Supporting glove

7.5 Spotting scope

7.6 Rifle stand to rest rifles between shots

8. **Shooting procedure**

8.1 Duration: 45 minutes

8.2 Distance: 22.5 metres

9. **Shooting competition**

9.1 Five minutes to prepare

9.2 Fire 10 shots at target 1 from the prone position with support.

9.3 Fire 10 shots at target 2 from a sitting or kneeling position with only rifle slings for support.

9.4 Fire 10 shots at target 3 from a free-hand standing position, without additional support.

10. **Scoring**

Only the shots on the scoring diagram on targets 1, 2 and 3 count.

Maximum of 300 points: 30 scoring diagrams x 1 shot x 10 points = 300 points.

11. **Targets**

Cadette target, 50mm diagrams, 10 scoring diagrams per target.

12. **Medals and prizes**

There will be a short prize-giving ceremony after the event.

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
